- NCIAC reserves the right to refuse the application of any participant whose merchandise or exhibit is deemed inappropriate.
- Participants must be ready to open for visitors by 10:00 am on Saturday, Oct 3rd and Sunday Oct 4th, 2009, and must remain in place until 6:00 pm on both days, unless directed otherwise by an authorized representative of NCIAC.
- At least one exhibitor representative must be in the booth during all public exhibit hours of 10am to 6pm. You may unload and set up at 7am each day.
- Vehicles must be removed from the festival grounds by 9:00 am on both days.
- Vendors are responsible for paying necessary sales tax to the State of Missouri.
