Driving instructions:

Orange barrels are a major obstacle in Kansas City this year so beware if you are using Mapquest or other mapping guides. There is construction on the I-29/I-35 Paseo Bridge, but it IS open. The road is closed north of Line Creek community Center at 68<sup>th</sup> Street so some routes that worked last year won't work in 2009.

Basically, Waukomis Drive is in the Northland and runs from Riverside north to 68<sup>th</sup> Street NW. It runs parallel to Highway 169 about one and one-half miles west of 169. There is an exit off of I-29 if you are going North on I-29 but none if you are going South on I-29.

*From South of the Missouri River, West of Kansas City:* Take I-435 north to Hwy. 152 and Barry Rd. exit. Go east on 152 to Hwy. 169. Go south on 169 to 68<sup>th</sup> Street. Go west on 68<sup>th</sup> St. to the construction site which is at Waukomis Drive. Turn left, south, and the park will be on your right in about 1 mile.

*From South of the Missouri River, Midtown Kansas City:* Take the Broadway Bridge north on Hwy. 169. Stay on 169 to the Englewood Exit. Exit right and then turn left or west on Englewood. Go to the end of Englewood and turn right. Line Creek Community Center will be just ahead on your left.

*From the North on I-29 or I-35:* From I-29 take Hwy. 152 east to Hwy. 169. From I-35 take Hwy. 152 west to Hwy. 169. Go south on 169 to the 68<sup>th</sup> Street exit. Go west on 68<sup>th</sup> St. until you reach the construction site at Waukomis Drive. Turn left, south, and the park will be on your right in about 1 mile.

*From South of the Missouri River, East of Kansas City:* Take I-435 north to Hwy. 152. Go west on 152 to Hwy. 169. Go south on 169 to 68<sup>th</sup> Street. Go west on 68<sup>th</sup> St. until you reach the construction site at Waukomis Drive. Turn left, south, and the park will be on your right in about 1 mile.
